Top Restaurants Suggestions for your Family:

Disney's Animal Kingdom Lodge

• Sanaa - The newer restaurant at Walt Disney World is a great one! The most exciting aspect of this restaurant at Kidani Village is the ceiling to floor view of the animals in the Savanna. The African menu is unique with entree items including chicken, shrimp, and lamb chops booked in the Tandoor Oven. Some other specialties include spice crusted game hen, banana leaf wrapped fish, New York Strip, ribs, and more. Even the desserts are unique including a dessert sampler, carrot halvah, vanilla coconut rice pudding, and even butter cake with orange and syrup. It has unique menu items and an incredible view! For the children in your group, they will still enjoy cheese pizza, chicken nuggets, fish, or macaroni and cheese. The regular kid friendly favorites!

Disney's Beach Club Resort

• Cape May Cafe Restaurant - This is one of the most popular restaurants at Disney World for families featuring a Clam Bake. • 1900 Park Fare - The best restaurant for Princess Character Dining is 1900 Park Fare at Disney's Grand Floridian Resort & Spa. This restaurant serves an all-you-can-eat dinner and dessert buffet. This restaurant is a very popular choice because the food and entertainment is the best for the Princess Dining. This restaurant features Cinderella, Prince Charming, and the Royal Family including the Step Mother and Step Sisters. Disney's Polynesian Resort

The breakfast is served family style (the bring it to your table all together and your family digs in) with typical breakfast favorites including scrambled eggs, bacon, sausage, fresh fruit, and potatoes. This restaurant also serves incredible pastries and Hawaiian bread. 'Ohanas is a popular Character Dining for kids of all ages. You will see Mickey Mouse, Lilo, Stitch, Goofy, and Pluto. Magic Kingdom Park

This is one of the most popular Character Dining at Walt Disney World, even for adults.
